Seminar descriptions:

Clearing each section of the ring: Did you check all 4 corners? Did you check front sides and back sides of each pile of straw? Did you check the single bale? Is there still a section of the ring that the dog did not get too, and there was a rat in there? Our dogs may be hunting beautifully, but we as the humans have to remember where they haven't been yet. This seminar will break up the course in sections, to make sure we are checking and clearing each section. Open to levels Senior and Master.

Intro to the rat: I'm a Newbie, beginner and I have no clue what I'm doing! Then this seminar is for you! This will go over what the Instinct test will look like, what you have to do, having the dog smell the rat, get out all your jitters and nervousness, and get you ready for the weekend. Open to levels Instinct and Novice.

Tunnels: "Go tunnel! Get in that tunnel! Go tunnel now!! Please go in the tunnel? We talked about this." We will start with a straight tunnel and work our way up to a 5 turn, dark Master tunnel. The dogs know there are no rats in the tunnel, and so it's not very fun for them. So we are going to make the tunnel awesome again! Bring plenty of treats!! Open to all levels.

Moving up to Open: You love this sport, your dog loves this sport, and now we need to start training it. It was just kind of luck the first couple of times, but now we need to get into more details and training. Open to levels Novice and Open.

Cost: Seminars will have 4 working dogs per hour and will cost \$25 per dog. One seminar per person per time slot, but that person may have a max of two dogs in the same hour. Auditing spot for the hour is free if you help work in the rings. Run throughs are \$15 per each run. Checks made out to COBRA. No cancellation unless someone fills your spot.

Rules:

- 1. We are running under all Barn Hunt Association Rules and Dandy Dog Training Rules.
- 2. Please pick up after yourselves and dogs. Poop can is across the parking lot on the other side. DO NOT put poop bags into the feed bins by the door.
- 3. You may use treats or toys in the rings since it is practice, but we ask that they are not dry crumbly treats or very small treats. Good size moist treats will help keep our straw clean for the weekend. Please take caution to not drop any treats in the rings or straw. String cheese, hot dogs, jerky are good options.
- 4. Seminar and run through signups will be sent to Talia Byers, 457 Bloserville Rd., Newville, PA 17241 Opening Monday July 2nd for all dogs entered in COBRA's July trial and club members. Opening for all non-trail dogs on Thursday July 5th sent to the above address. Closes when full or up until day of.
