We utilize the Agility Unscrambled program which allows e-mail confirmations and results dissemination. We will send out electronic confirmations and electronic results after the trial. Please make sure your e-mail address on your entry form is legible.

DAILY FEES AND PACKAGE RATES: Classes will be \$12.00 run; Weekend package will be \$125.00 JR Handlers \$10.00 run

DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES: We will accept day of show entries provided the trial has not filled. The day of show entry fee is \$15 a run with no package deals. Day of Show entries will only be taken during check-in. It is recommended that you e-mail lmsphd@gmail.com the week before the trial to see if we have room for Day of Show Entries.

ENTRY DATA: There is no need to overnight entries. The trial closing date for Pre-entries is July 20, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. **We reserve the right to refuse any entry. Anyone who is not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.**

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn in the event a dog and/or handler is dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date. Refunds after the closing date will be honored only for bitches in season. A \$10.00 processing fee per dog will be assessed for ANY refund. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, weather, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond our control.

Accepted entries may be changed prior to July 27 at 9:00 p.m. E-mail change requests to lmsphd@gmail.com. No changes will be made at the trial, so please read your confirmations carefully. If you have questions, e-mail. Move-ups during the trial do not constitute an entry change and will be happily accommodated!

Multiple **e-mail** confirmations will be sent; at a minimum, a preliminary confirmation will be sent when your entry is received and processed and a final confirmation will be sent just prior to the trial. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. I-83 to Exit 32 (Newberrytown Exit-old exit #13), Take Rt. 382 North to Lewisberry, approximately 3 miles to flashing traffic light. Turn left, on South Rt. 177 toward Rossville, travel approximately 3 miles. Turn right on Mt. Airy Rd. (across from Lake Pinchot Park Office) and continue 1.7 miles to site on left.

RT. 15 to Mechanicsburg-Bowmansdale Exit, Rt. 114 towards Ski Roundtop, At the split, DO NOT FOLLOW 114, continue straight on North York Road. Turn left on East Mt. Airy Rd (at Mt. Pleasant Church of God) pass Ski Roundtop (on right) and continue to “T” intersection. Turn right on Pinetown Road, then take first left on Mt. Airy Road. Site is immediately on the right.
