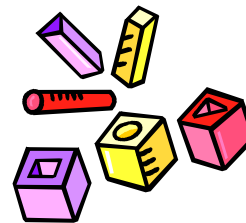
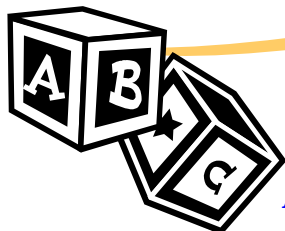
Contacts & Weaves!

This one day seminar is geared towards the dog/handler team getting ready to trial at the novice level or above. All contact work will deal with stopped contacts (2 on 2 off or 4 on the floor). Exercises and games will be taught to strengthen the behaviors. Some sequencing and course work will be done to look at how handling impacts these skills. Dogs must be comfortable with all equipment.

- Donna made the transition from obedience to agility in the mid-1990's. She has achieved the highest titles in USDAA and AKC agility. She currently runs a Pembroke Welsh Corgi and two Border Collies. She has won and placed at numerous USDAA Steeplechase and Grand Prix qualifiers in the highly competitive Northeast region.
- In 2004, Donna left the public school teaching profession to devote her energy and talents to teaching agility. Her students frequently comment that it is this "teaching skill" that makes her a successful instructor.
- Donna excels at bringing training techniques to her agility students and places emphasis on the handler-dog relationship to create a dog that loves to work. She works with teams with motivational issues to bring them confidence and drive. She also works with driven teams that require improvement in handling skills and self control, while maintaining that speed and drive. Because Donna handles both mini and open dogs she can address the specifics of running a small or a large dog.

Only 12 working spots are available for this seminar with 25 auditor spots. Full payment must be received to reserve your spot. This seminar will be held indoors on sand/rubber mulch. Building is fan cooled. A/C kennel runs can be rented by contacting Stephanie Capkovic at Bella Vista Training Center – 717-432-0750. Water will be available for the dogs. Dogs are required to be comfortable with all the equipment, not be dog or people aggressive and should be at the intermediate to novice level of agility.
