Directions to show site:

I-83 to Exit 32 (Newberrytown Exit-old exit #13), Take Rt. 382 North to Lewisberry, approximately 3 miles to flashing traffic light. Turn left, on South Rt. 177 toward Rossville, travel approximately 3 miles. Turn right on Mt. Airy Rd. (across from Lake Pinchot Park Office) and continue 1.7 miles to site on left.

RT. 15 to Mechanicsburg-Bowmansdale Exit, Rt. 114 towards Ski Roundtop. At the split, DO NOT FOLLOW 114, continue straight on North York Road. Turn left on East Mt. Airy Rd (at Mt. Pleasant Church of God), past Ski Roundtop (on right) and continue to "T" intersection. Turn right on Pinetown Road, then take first left on Mt. Airy Road. Site is immediately on the right.

Notice to Exhibitors:

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area, and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

Eligibility:

This trial is open to all teacup dogs (which are dogs 17" and under at the withers), over the age of 12 months except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Your dog must be registered to participate in TDAA Trials. There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register the first day of the trial. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com

Handicapped Handlers: Disabled handlers will be allowed an additional 4 seconds in Standard and Games classes using numbered courses. A copy of a disabled parking permit must be sent with the entry.

Exhibitors will be allowed to set-up at 7:00 AM. Measuring for all dogs without a permanent jump height card will be available from 7:30 to 8:00 AM. There will be a general briefing at 8:00 AM to familiarize all participants with TDAA rules. Judging will start 8:15 AM. Obstacle familiarization will be held before the first run of the day.

GAMES CLASSES

Judge's Briefing on the day of the trial supersedes any previous briefing.

FULLHOUSE

The objective of Full House is to successfully accumulate required points, and before time expires, gather the elements of the Full House. Three of a kind- 3 single jumps; Two of a kind – 2 "circles" (tunnel, chute, or tire); Joker – 1 contact or weaves

NEAR AND FAR

The objective of this game is to negotiate a course as numbered. At two specific sections on the course the dog will go ahead to perform obstacles (the far section) while the handler stays behind a specific line. Crossing the containment line will result in a fault. At the beginner level, one crossing of the line will be permitted. At the intermediate and superior level, crossing of the line will result in a non qualifying score.

BLACK JACK: The object of the game is to accumulate 21 points only. More or less than 21 points is a non-qualifying score. The table stops the clock.

TUNNEL SNOOKER: Snooker is a two part game. Each part is played and scored on a different basis. The opening sequence begins by performing red obstacles, the tunnels, valued at 1 point each. A successfully performed red obstacle earns the team the right to attempt one of the numbered obstacles on the course, valued at 2 to 7 points. Teams earn those points if the dog successfully performs the numbered obstacle. The opening sequence ends when you have taken 3 of the red obstacles and a chosen colored obstacle. The closing sequence is to run the numbered course 2 thru 7.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying. A prize will be awarded to all qualifying dogs.

Move-Ups: Move-ups will be accepted for dogs earning a title at a show prior to the closing date, 7/23/10. Move-up requests must be in writing but may be sent via email. Move-ups will be only allowed between days at the trial.

FEO Runs

FEO – TDAA now offers FEO (For Exhibition Only) runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. FEO dogs will run last in their jump height. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles or certificates. No treats or food allowed in ring. FEO teams will receive 1.5 times the Standard Course Time for their run.

Obstacles to be Used

The following is a list of obstacles to be used:

A-Frame (8' ramp w/slats) Weave Poles (20" centers) Table (36"X36")

Closed (collapsed) Tunnel Single and Winged Jumps Tire Jump (24")

Open (pipe) Tunnel Dogwalk (8' ramp w/slats)

Slatless Teeter (8' ramp)

All obstacles meet TDAA equipment size requirements.

Warm-ups – a warm up area consisting 1 agility jump will be available. One obstacle familiarization will be held before the trial starts each day.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All dogs that do not have a permanent jump height card must be measured before judging begins. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. To figure leg to shoulder ratio: Height from the elbow to the ground ÷ height at the withers = % (ratio). If that percentage is less than 50% and meets the height requirement then the dog can jump at the next lower height.

- 8" and under at the withers jumps 4"
- 12" and under at the withers jumps 8"
- 15" and under at the withers jumps 12"
- 17" and under at the withers jumps 16"

Dogs competing with either a body-type (long-backed, dwarfish legs/deep chested, or weight-to-height provision) exemption, veteran jump height exemption, or both exemptions, will be scored and placed with the height class they measure into.

Jump Height Exemptions:

Special provisions are made for dogs that are long-backed, have a weight-to-height exemption, or who have dwarfish legs (see rules for complete description of height exemptions at: www.k9tdaa.com). A jump height exemption (next lower height) will also be granted to veteran dogs (dogs of at least 7 years of age).

Standard Class

Beginner Agility – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

Intermediate Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Agility – Only dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Class

Games I – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

Games II – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TGI) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Entries:

Pre-entries close on July 23, 2010 after which time entries cannot be cancelled, altered, or substituted. Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms, one dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries **without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached are NOT acceptable**. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. The club will refund all but ten dollars of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such a claim for refund by letter (not e-mail) before the closing date.

Day of event entries will be accepted at an additional fee of \$3.00 per run/per day. **Day of event entries must be given to the secretary no less than 30 minutes before the judge's first briefing.** TDAA Dog Registration Numbers may be applied for and received at the event so that your dog can participate in this trial.

How the Fast Track Move-Up Works

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginners to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginners, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. It is also possible to move up from Games I to Games III in the same manner.

A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. The dog's owner must submit a copy of title certificates for the dog.

A dog moving up on the Fast Track will not be eligible for placement within the class that he/she received the qualifying score.
